

This program is created for students with an interest in law enforcement or related forensic sciences. Students will learn general problem-solving skills and how physics, geometry, triangles and the Pythagorean theorem, simple algebraic math, sin/cosine problems relating to blood splatter and bullet trajectory, and other science disciplines assist in solving a crime scene. After the classroom portion of the lecture, students will identify and process a mock crime scene by collecting evidence using the most up-to-date, modern techniques and methodologies. The class is designed to challenge all students while having fun solving the crime. Class is taught by current and former Law Enforcement/Detectives.
