TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN ORDINANCE NO. 2019-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 33, "POLICE DEPARTMENT", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN, PERTAINING TO MINIMUM POSITION QUALIFICATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Manalapan, in the County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 33, "Police Department", of the Code of the Township of Manalapan, Section 33-12, "Minimum Position Qualifications", subsection 33-12A, "Police Officer", subparagraph 33-12.A(4) "Education", be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:
- "(4) Education or Military Service. Must have an associate's degree or the equivalent of 60 college credits or shall have served in the armed forces of the United States for a minimum of two years and received an honorable discharge."
- **Section 2.** All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **Section 3.** Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.
- **Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
