

## MANALAPAN RECREATION CENTER SPLASH PAD RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Manalapan Recreation Center Splash Pad was created through funding provided by the Manalapan Recreation department Dedicated Trust Fund and a 2014 Monmouth County Municipal Open Space Grant. All visitors to the Manalapan Recreation Center are welcome to utilize the Splash Pad facility while adhering to the following regulations:

### General Rules

- The Splash Pad is open to all ages; Individuals and families are welcome
- Organized group outings are not permitted
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult
- The facility will be open 7 days a week, Memorial Day through Labor Day from 11:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. . ***\*\*Please note that summer recreation program runs from June 29th to August 7<sup>th</sup>. The Splash Park will be very crowded during those program dates from 11am to 3pm.***
- Splash Pad area may close for inclement weather, Manalapan Recreation sponsored programs or other reason deemed appropriate by the Manalapan Recreation department.
- Splash Pad area will close immediately upon Lightning Detection notification and will not reopen until all-clear has sounded
- Use facility at your own risk
- We are not responsible for loss or damage to personal property
- Open wounds must be covered appropriately

### Attire:

- Appropriate water attire is required to use the facility
- Infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers unless they have been properly toilet trained
- Diapers must be changed and disposed of outside the Splash Pad fencing
- Bare feet, smooth bottomed or rubber soled water shoes are required

### Miscellaneous:

The following are not permitted within the Splash Pad area:

- No food, beverages\*, gum, glass containers or tobacco products
- No lawn or beach chairs
- No climbing or hanging on fence and/or water features
- No skateboards, rollerblades/skates or bicycles
- No unsafe play, inappropriate language or disruptive behavior
- No radios or amplified devices
- No pets

\* Plastic water bottles and baby bottle/sippy cups are permitted.

Violators of the above regulations may be removed from the Splash Pad facility.
