

Important Election Information

Governor Murphy has signed a law mandating the November 3, 2020 General Election in New Jersey be conducted primarily by mail in ballots:

- All active registered voters will automatically be mailed a ballot no later than October 5th. If you have not received a ballot by October 13th, please contact the County Clerk's Office at 732-431-7790.
- Ballots can be returned in one of four ways 1) via U.S.P.S. (all ballots will have a postage paid return envelope); 2) via secure ballot drop boxes located throughout the County; 3) in-person to the Board of Elections Office in Freehold; or 4) at your polling location on Election Day.
- There will be limited in-person polling locations open on Election Day, where voters can vote by provisional paper ballot only or drop off their completed mail in ballot. All voters will receive a post card by October 23rd indicating their polling location.
- There will be no voting machines, except for disabled voters. If you have a disability and need an accessible vote by mail ballot, please contact the County Clerk's Office at 732-431-7790.

It is strongly encouraged that you complete and return your mail in ballot as soon as you receive it. If you choose to vote on a paper provisional ballot at the polls, your ballot will not be counted until after all of the mail in ballots are counted, per State law.
