Dear Property Owner:

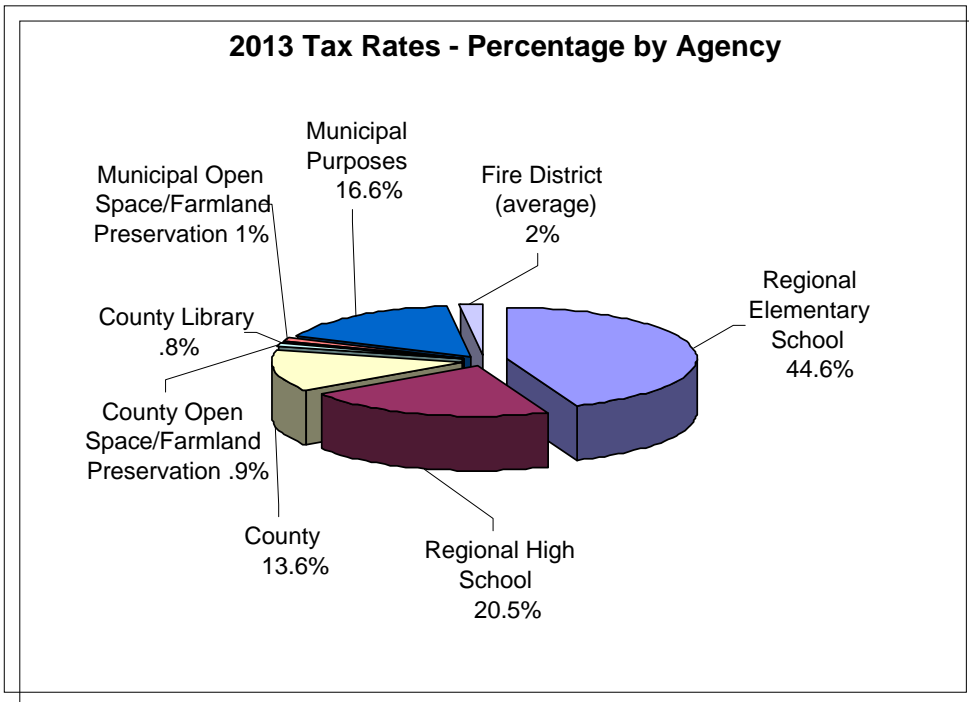
Enclosed is your 2013 Final/2014 Preliminary Tax Bill. Please note that the Third and Fourth Quarters represent the full amount of your 2013 taxes, retroactive to January 1st, 2013. First and Second Quarters of 2014 are an estimate based on half of the total 2013 taxes.

Property taxes are determined by separate and independent agencies as shown below:

In addition to the above there is a local Fire District Tax that will be \$.039 for Fire District 1 and \$.047 for Fire District 2.
