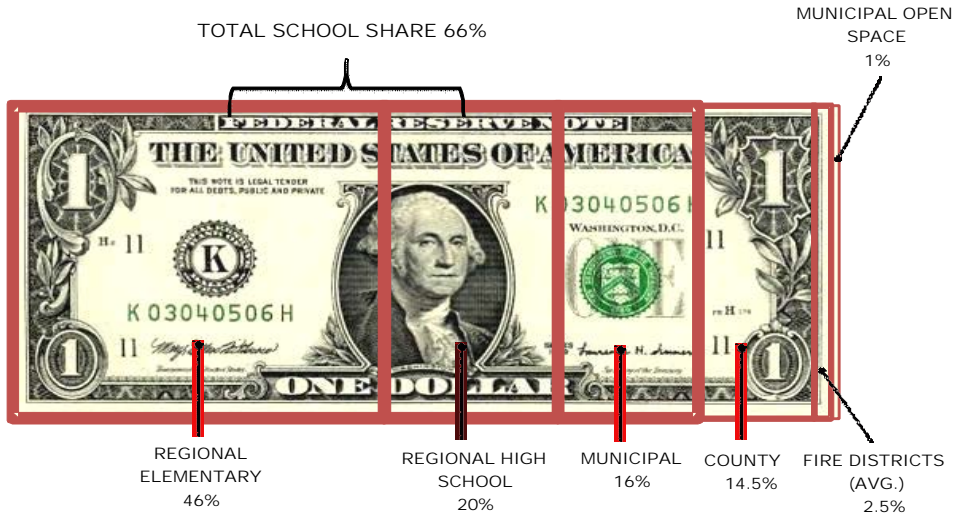


# Township of Manalapan

Dear Property Owner:

Enclosed is your tax bill which is made up from numerous budgets set by different governing bodies: the school budgets, the county budget, fire districts and the township's municipal budget. While the township only has oversight and jurisdiction over the municipal portion of the bill, we are required to collect all taxes and then pay each district their full share.

The Township Committee continues to provide high quality municipal services to the residents of Manalapan while minimizing the impact to the township taxpayers.



As you can see on the exhibit to the left, the Township only retains sixteen cents of every dollar collected. If you have any questions concerning any of the amounts please contact that agency directly.

- **Recycling Reminder** – Recycling will not be collected in plastic bags. The County has instituted a zero tolerance policy on recycling in plastic bags; therefore, the garbage company will leave it at the curb. Please place recycling loose in a container at the curb to ensure it will be collected. Containers should not be larger than 64 gallons.
