### PUBLIC PORTION OF MEETING:

### MEETING IS CALLED TO ORDER BY THE MAYOR:

MAYOR MCNABOE: Okay at this time I'm going to call the public portion of this meeting to order. Today the township's special meeting is being brought to you live with the ability to call in and ask questions. As the governor requested we are practicing social distancing by not having all of the governing body members here. If you'd like to speak when we open to the public comments sessions, please dial (973) 854-6173 and then you put in this meeting ID number and that number is 112 177 6064. When you want to speak you'll press star nine to raise your hand and you'll have the ability to speak or you'll be called upon. If you are unable to connect to us, please dial we have a landline here for the township (732) 446-8303. We ask the public to bear with us as we go remotely to Mayor Musich, Committeeman Barry Jacobson, and Committeeman Nelson for this special meeting. Before we begin, I'll read the compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act or the Deputy Mayor will read the first part. I'll read the second, Deputy Mayor.

MRS. COHEN: Thank you. Pursuant to Section Five of the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this meeting of the Manalapan Township Committee was sent and advertised in the Asbury Park Press. A copy of that notice was posted on the bulletin board where public notices are displayed in the municipal building. In addition, a copy of this notice is and has been available to the public in its on file in the office of the municipal clerk. Accordingly, this meeting is deemed in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

MAYOR MCNABOE: Great, thank you. The Township of Manalapan Television Network will be recording this meeting of the township committee for re-broadcast on MTTN channel 77 on Cablevision and channel 42 on Verizon Fios. By attending this evening, attendees acknowledge this recording and agree to allow their image to be broadcast on MTTN channel 77 and Verizon Fios channel 42. All attendees and participants agree to conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for a public gathering. Inappropriate behavior or gatherings creating a disturbance or safety hazard are prohibited inside this meeting. Individual speakers should be

advised that no right of privacy protects a citizen's public comment made in a public forum. Any statement made by a member of the public to promote or alter public opinion about a candidate for political office, political party or interest groups are inappropriate and in violation of MTTN broadcast policy. Accordingly, all participants bear responsibility for their own statements and commentary. Before we begin, I read the disclaimers so Ms. Rose we're going to need a roll call of the governing body please.
