# **Registration Information**

Camp runs from

June 27 - Aug. 5

(no program July 4) and is open to resident children currently in **grades K-7.** 

Children currently in **grade 8 & grade 9** may apply as a Junior or Senior CIT

Registration max <u>600</u> Campers Registration Fees and Dates

# If registered by:

by May 13 ..... \$700.00 between May 16-June 1..... \$725.00

There will be a 2.95% convenience fee added for registering with a credit card.

There will be NO group color choice this year. Camper group placement will be random. Placement requests will not be accepted.



# Please note shuttle bus transportation (to and from program) will *NOT* be offered in 2022.

The After Care option extends the camp day to 4:30 p.m.

After Care may be available if the minimum number of registrants is met and staffing allows. After Care fee is \$250 for the entire 6 week program (28 days). Daily fee for after care is \$11.

Please register for the waiting list if you are interested in After Care.

## Special Needs (Non-Allergy)

Is your child classified by the Manalapan-Englishtown Board of Education? If so, special needs accommodations may be available depending on individual circumstances.

Please register early so we can properly plan to care for the needs of your camper.

Space is limited!

Registrations received after May 10 may interfere with our ability to do so.

# Attention parents of ALL grades!

For this year's Summer Program, there will be no choice of group color.

Register your child in the grade he/she is currently in. In early June, campers will be placed into color groups randomly (within their grade).

Campers may ask to be placed with 1 friend. Information on how to request the friend placement will be emailed prior to group creation.

The NJDOH has lifted the restrictions for camps so group interaction is permitted once again!

#### DID YOU KNOW???

Anyone employed in Manalapan Township may be eligible to register their child for the Summer Program.

### Fundamentals of the Manalapan Summer Recreation Program

### Location and Length

# Organization

All of the camp groups are centrally located at the Manalapan Recreation Center directly across from the Municipal Building on Route 522.

The Recreation Center is conducive to a variety of activities for the campers while maintaining effective supervision.

The program runs from Monday, June 27th through Friday, Aug 5th (No program on July 4th).

The final day of the program August 5th will be a half day (ends at 12:00 pm).

There will be no aftercare this year.

For effective management and organization, the camp groups are divided into four clusters.

**Cluster 1** includes all campers who are currently in kindergarten and first grades.

Cluster 2 includes all campers who are currently in second and third grades.

**Cluster 3** includes all campers who are currently in fourth and fifth grades.

Cluster 4 includes all campers who are currently in sixth and seventh grades

Our Cluster Directors are Certified school teachers. Each grade is also subdivided into smaller groups headed by a Group Supervisor. The Group Supervisor positions are filled by either adults with teaching experience or upper classmen in college with significant experience as a summer camp employee. To assist with visibility and management, each group will be assigned to a specific colored T-shirt.



### Camp lunch:

Lunch service will not be offered this summer. Campers should bring a non-perishable lunch to camp each day as we do not have refrigeration.

### Splash Pad:

The Splash Pad facility, located on the western end of the Manalapan Recreation Center will be available for use by our younger campers during the program.
