Deadline

All work must be submitted via email to ClerkContest@co.monmouth.nj.us no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, October 3, 2025. Late entries will not be accepted.

Criteria

- The contest is open to high school students enrolled in grades 9 through 12 for the 2025-2026 academic school year who reside in Monmouth County and/or attend a high school located in Monmouth County.
- Photo must capture a historical location relevant to the Revolutionary War era in Monmouth County.
- All entries must be submitted in digital format via email.
- Photo may be black-and-white or color.
- Entries must be the entrant's original work. AI is not permitted. Editing of the image is permitted only for the purposes of enhancing photo quality.
- Entries will be judged based on overall quality, artistic expression and relevance to the contest theme.

How to Enter

Submission Information: Photos entries must be submitted via email to the address ClerkContest@co.monmouth.nj.us with "2025 High School Photography Contest" in the subject line. No entries will be accepted after October 3, 2025, at 5 PM.

Specifications and format: All entries must be in JPG format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Preferred method to transmit photo is via email as a file attachment. Photos sent as an embedded image in the body of an email will not be accepted. If the file is too large to send as an attachment, entries may be be transmitted via link to a photo sharing account such as Dropbox or Google Drive as long as the file is made accessible without requiring permission to be requested.

Required Information: The following must accompany the photo entry in the body of the email:

- Student's Name
- High School and Grade for the 2025-2026 school year
- Full home address and best phone number to reach you
- Name and email of a parent/guardian
- Brief description (sentence or two) about what is captured in the photo and its significance to the Revolutionary War period in Monmouth County.

Rules & Eligibility

Limit to one photograph per entry and entries must be original work. All submissions become the property of the Monmouth County Clerk's Office, and photos may be published at the Monmouth County Clerk's Office's discretion along with the winning entrant's name, grade, and high school in print, electronically, and/or digitally. Authorization is also granted to the Monmouth County Clerk's Office to distribute and publish on print, online and social media channels. Submitted photographs will be archived by the Monmouth County Archives and become the property of the Monmouth County Clerk's Office. All entered photographs will be retained by the Monmouth County Clerk's Office for future use, publication and archiving purposes.
