TO OUR CUSTOMERS:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December 16, 2025, Veolia Water New Jersey, Inc. (“VWNJ” or “Company”), a public utility of the State of New Jersey, filed a petition (“Petition”) with the Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) of the State of New Jersey for approval of an increase in its base rates for water and sewer service. The Petition was filed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-21 and N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.12 other relevant statutes and regulations.

The Company is requesting an overall increase in water revenues of \$38,621,529, or approximately 9.82% above the annual level of revenues for the test year period ending March 31, 2026. The Company believes the increase is necessary in order for it to be able to continue to provide safe, adequate and proper service to its customers and to prevent the impairment of its financial integrity.

The proposed base rates for all customers are contained in the tariff sheets and the Petition was filed with the Board. The present and proposed rates for monthly billing for General Metered Service (Former Toms River) are as follows:
