

**TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-10**

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 226, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", ARTICLE XII, "EMERGENCY NO PARKING", SECTION 226-31, "DESIGNATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY NO-PARKING", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Manalapan, County of Monmouth in the State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION ONE. Chapter 226, "Vehicles and Parking", Article XII, "Emergency Snow Parking", Section 226-31 "Designation of Snow Emergency No-Parking", of the Code of the Township of Manalapan, as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented to read, in full, as follows:

"§ 226-31. Designation of snow emergency no-parking.

- A. Whenever a snowfall results in an accumulation of one inch or more of snow, an emergency shall exist, and no vehicle shall be parked on any street or highway or portion thereof. The aforesaid parking prohibition shall remain in effect until the snowfall has ceased and until the street or highway has been plowed.
- B. Whenever the National Weather Service forecasts that a snowfall of four (4) inches or more shall occur within twenty-four (24) hours, an emergency shall exist, and no vehicle shall be parked on any street or highway or portion thereof. The aforesaid parking prohibition shall remain in effect until the snowfall has ceased and until the street or highway has been plowed.
- C. Whenever a state of emergency is declared by the Governor, an emergency shall exist, and no vehicle shall be parked on any street or highway or portion thereof. The aforesaid parking prohibition

shall remain in effect until the snowfall has ceased and until the street or highway has been plowed.

- D. Any vehicle parked in violation of this section shall be deemed to be a nuisance and may be removed. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of removal and storage of the vehicles before regaining possession thereof."

SECTION TWO. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION THREE. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
