



New Jersey Natural Gas to Host Energy Assistance Days September, October and Early November

Customers can attend one of 27 Energy Assistance Days across Monmouth, Ocean and Morris counties to get connected with grants and programs to help pay their energy bills.

Energy Assistance Highlights:

- New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG) continues to expand Energy Assistance Days to provide customers with greater access to vital resources.
- Effective October 1, 2026, NJNG along with community action agencies will begin processing applications, assisting them every step of the way.
- In fiscal 2025, NJNG helped connect more than 28,000 customers with over \$16.5 million in energy assistance from federal, state, county and nonprofit sources.

NJNG's Energy Assistance Days are designed to connect customers with grants and resources to help pay their energy bills. Customers of varying income levels could benefit from more than one of 10 programs, yet many do not realize they're eligible. For example, a family of four with a household income of up to \$164,337 may qualify.

These **in-person** events — **many available by foot or public transportation** — provide customers greater opportunities to access programs and **one-on-one** support with the eligibility and application process.

Energy Assistance Days enhances NJNG's efforts to ensure customers have access to vital relief programs, and complements our year-round efforts. So far in fiscal 2026, NJNG has supported nearly 28,000 customers, connecting them with essential resources to help manage their energy bills.

Energy Assistance Programs

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)**

This federally funded program administered through the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (NJDCA) provides an annual bill credit to help pay heating and medically necessary cooling bills. This program benefits limited- to moderate-income households, including multi-generational households and seniors.

Universal Service Fund (USF)**

This state-funded program administered through the NJDCA provides a monthly credit directly to natural gas and/or electric utility accounts. This program benefits limited- to moderate-income households, including multi-generational households and seniors.

USF Fresh Start**

State-funded, the programs provides forgiveness to customers with a minimum overdue balance of \$60 at the time of their enrollment in USF. Effective October 1, 2024, USF enrollees can only participate in Fresh Start once every five years.

New Jersey Board of Public Utilities Payment Assistance for Gas and Electric (PAGE)**

This program provides eligible low- to moderate-income households with an overdue balance of \$100 or more with an annual grant to help pay their natural gas and/or electricity bills and maintain their service.

New Jersey SHARES Smart Utility**

This nonprofit helps income-qualified households that do not qualify for other federal or state utility assistance programs with grants to assist in times of temporary financial crisis.

New Jersey SHARES**

This nonprofit provides annual grants to help pay natural gas, electricity, water and telecommunications bills, as well as rent, to qualified households experiencing a temporary financial crisis.

New Jersey Lifeline Credit Program**

Offered through the New Jersey Department of Health and Human Services, this program provides individuals with disabilities and PAAD and SSI recipients with help paying their natural gas and electricity bills.

New Jersey Comfort Partners Program**

This no-cost program provides income-eligible customers with free energy-saving measures designed to help lower energy bills while improving home comfort. Measures may include insulation and seal up as well as the installation of a smart thermostat, low-flow showerheads and more.

Whole Home Energy Assessment*

NJNG's SAVEGREEN® energy-efficiency program provides customers with a free* Whole Home Energy Assessment. During this home energy analysis, an NJNG certified auditor will evaluate HVAC and water heating equipment, basement and/or attic insulation levels and more to identify energy-saving opportunities that can help homeowners and renters save on their energy bills.

NJNG's Home Weatherization Program*

Offered through NJNG's SAVEGREEN program, qualified moderate-income customers may be eligible to receive up to \$14,000** in free weatherization measures, including insulation and seal up, to help reduce energy usage and lower their energy bills.

**Terms and conditions apply. You must be an NJNG income-qualifying, residential customer whose primary residence is a single- or in a multifamily dwelling with up to three units. You must own your home for a minimum of one year. Homes 0-5 years old or under a builder's warranty are excluded. Both renters and homeowners must meet the income guidelines.
